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Minutes

August 10th, 2026 - Regular Town Board Meeting

- ❖ The regular monthly Town Board Meeting of the Town of Emmet was called to order on the above date by Chairman Tyler Dahlke at 7:05 PM. The meeting was held in the Halder Community Hall, 135125 Halder Drive, Mosinee, WI. Present were Town Board members Tyler Dahlke, Lisa Baur, Dan Knetter, Mike Maguire, and Jerry Fitzgerald.
- ❖ The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ Motion by Dan Knetter, second by Lisa Baur to approve the printed minutes of the July 14th, 2026 Town Board Meeting. Motion carried.
- ❖ Treasurer Maguire presented the financial report for August 2026. The major expense was the Schuette Road culverts. Costs for the remaining TOWN projects and projected income was discussed. Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to approve the financial report. Motion carried.
- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to approve payment of bills with check numbers 19259 through 19273, wages, and payments made electronically. Motion carried.
- ❖ Clerk's Communications & Reports:
 - No building permits have been issued since the last meeting.
 - EMS grants for snow disaster and flood disaster have been applied for.
 - Culvert cost share form for Maple Lead culverts has been sent to Marathon County.
 - The equalized value of the Town of Emmet is now \$160,201,500.00.
 - Speed limit signs have been installed.
 - Garbage cost for 2027 will be \$23.49 per month per household. This does not include the fuel surcharge.
 - The estimated population of the Town is currently at 913.
 - There will be a slight increase in the GTA payment for 2027. The final numbers will be available in October 2026.
- ❖ Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to appoint Mary Nest to the election board. Motion carried.
- ❖ A summary of the completed culvert projects was discussed.
- ❖ The culvert on Sugar Bush Road will be completed this week, a culvert on Balsam Road at the intersection of Schuette Road will tentatively be scheduled for replacement, as well as the culvert on Long Drive.
- ❖ The Chairman will schedule brushing and limbing on Still Hill Road before the winter season.
- ❖ The preliminary budget was discussed. The Clerk will have some preliminary numbers for the September meeting.
- ❖ Board members will bring suggestions for some changes in the Town of Emmet ordinance and zoning at the September meeting.
- ❖ The Clerk will send in registrations for the WTA fall workshop in Stevens Point for Monday, September 21st, 2026.

- ❖ Chairman & Supervisors' Reports:
 - Updates were made on Town Hall electrical improvements. These include a new line from the transformer and electrical boxes.
 - A new resident on South Bayside Drive had questions about the access trail.
 - A contractor will be hired to assist with the brushing and limbing on Still Hill Road.
- ❖ Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to set the date for the next meeting for Tuesday, September 8th, 2026 at 7:00 PM.
- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to adjourn. Motion carried. Time: 8:19 PM.
