Minutes

Regular Town Board Meeting - April 14th, 2026

- ❖ The regular monthly Town Board Meeting of the Town of Emmet was called to order on the above date by Chairman Tyler Dahlke at 7:00 PM. The meeting was held in the Halder Community Hall, 135125 Halder Drive, Mosinee, WI. Present were Town Board members Tyler Dahlke, Lisa Baur, Dan Knetter, Mike Maguire, and Jerry Fitzgerald. Also present were Ben Nechuta, Randy Worden, Raket Mata, Rosalie Michlig, and Al McHugh.
- ❖ The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ Motion by Dan Knetter, second by Lisa Baur to approve the printed minutes of the March 3, 2026 Town Board meeting. Motion carried.
- ❖ Treasurer Mike Maguire presented the financial report for April 2026. Major receipts were the transportation money, April lottery credit, and culvert shared cost payment from Marathon County. Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to approve the financial report. Motion carried.
- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to approve payment of bills with check numbers 19150-19181, wages, and payments made electronically. Motion carried.
- ❖ Clerk's Communications & Reports:
 - No building permits were issued since the last meeting.
 - There were 276 votes cast in the April election, which included 25 absentee ballots.
 - The Clerk has filed the following regulatory forms: CT Form, recycling report, & the injury and illness report. The elevator permit has been applied for.
 - A grant form for disaster payment from the snowstorms will be applied for.
- ❖ Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to approve the ordinance allowing Town Board Members to participate in Town meetings by Zoom. Motion carried.
- ❖ Motion by Baur, second by Dahlke to approve an operator's license for Taylor Baehr. Motion carried.
- ❖ The Clerk informed the Board that the fuel surcharge on Harter's Garbage and Recyclable bill can be put on the assessment charge on the taz bill for Town residents for garbage and recyclable collection. This will be further explained to the audience at the annual meeting.
- ❖ The Board will meetin on Tuesday, April 21st, 2026 at 7:00 PM to inspect culvert and road damage due to the excessive rain during the storm. The Clerk will post a notice.

- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to accept the dust control bid from Kafka Dust Busters at \$1.58 per gallon. Motion carried.
- ❖ Chairman & Supervisors' Reports:
 - Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to pay Ascent Construction the remaining portion of their bill. Motion carried.
 - Board discussion of repairing culverts due to washouts.
 - Town roads that need priority attention are the far west end of Sugar Bush Road and the far west end of Twin Creek Road.

- The DNR has been in contact with the Town of Emmet regarding the Schuette Road culvert replacements.
- The Board discussed plans for graveling and ditching on Town roads.
- The Clerk will apply for state emergency grant assistance as a result of the snowstorm in March 2026.

- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to set the date for the next Town Board meeting for Tuesday, May 12th, 2026 at 7:00 PM at the Halder Community Hall. Motion carried.
