Minutes

July 14th, 2026 Regular Town Board Meeting

- ❖ The regular monthly Town Board Meeting of the Town of Emmet was called to order on the above date by Chairman Tyler Dahlke at 7:00 PM. The meeting was held in the Halder Community Hall, 135125 Halder Drive, Mosinee, WI. Present were Town Board members Tyler Dahlke, Lisa Baur, Dan Knetter, Mike Maguire, and Jerry Fitzgerald. Also present were Shannon Baumann and Ben Nechuta.
- ❖ The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
- ❖ Motion by Dan Knetter, second by Lisa Baur to approve the printed minutes of the June 9th, 2026 Town Board Meeting. Motion carried.
- ❖ Treasurer Mike Maguire presented the financial report for July 2026. The major receipt was the quarterly transportation aid. Major expenses were for culverts, culvert replacement, road granite, and machine and equipment hire. Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to approve the financial report. Motion carried.
- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to approve payment of bills with checks numbered 19228 through 19258, wages, and payments made electronically. Motion carried.
- ❖ Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to approve payment of the two percent fire dues to the three fire departments (Stratford, Edgar, and Mosinee). Motion carried.
- ❖ Clerk's Communications and Reports:
 - No building permits have been issued since the last meeting.
 - The Clerk has filed a grant application with the State for assistance resulting from the large snowfall this past spring. Depending upon the FEMA distribution, an application will be filed for assistance due to the flooding this past spring.
 - The primary election will be on August 11th, 2026. The Town of Emmet will NOT be using drop boxes.
 - The bill for the website domain and maintenance is for two years. By paying for two years, the Town has saved some money.
 - The Clerk has filed the MOE report.
- ❖ After Board discussion, motion by Knetter, second by Baur to adopt a resolution to lower the speed limits on the following designated roads:
 - Sugar Bush Road- from Highway S to Badger Road
 - Cardinal Lane - from Highway 153 to Highway P
 - Twin Creek Road - from Highway S to Deer Bush RoadMotion carried. All ayes. The resolution will be posted on the website and sent to the Sheriff's Department. Signs will also be erected.
- ❖ The Board discussed the upcoming culvert projects. Maple Leaf culvert has been replaced. Schuette Road culverts will be replaced when they arrive. A large culvert on Sugar Bush Road will be replaced when the culvert arrives from the supplier. No decision was made on replacing Burns Creek Road culverts. Those culverts will be dependent upon what Marathon County and the DNR authorizes.

- ❖ Chairman & Supervisors' Reports:
 - Bushing will be needed on Still Hill Road.
 - New electrical service will be installed for the Town Hall. The electrician has been scheduled.
 - The Board discussed with a resident about the possibility of selling the small parcel of land on Burns Creek Road. No action taken.
- ❖ Motion by Lisa Baur, second by Dan Knetter to go into closed session. Motion carried. Baur- aye, Knetter- aye, Dahlke- aye.
- ❖ Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to return to open session. Motion by Baur, second by Knetter to approve a wage increase for the Town employee. Motion carried.
- ❖ Due to the election, motion by Knetter, second by Baur to set the date for the next Town Board meeting for Monday, August 10th, 2026 at 7:00 PM at the Halder Community Hall, 135125 Halder Drive. Motion carried.
- ❖ Motion by Knetter, second by Baur to adjourn. Motion carried. Time: 8:11 PM.
